

## **MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

### **MEETING HELD ON FEBRUARY 1, 2000**

The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock A.M. with Chairman Loren Bouma presiding. Members present were William Vander Maten, Vernon Beernink, Loren Bouma and Stanley L. De Haan. Bernard L. Smith was absent.

Committee reports were given this date.

Mark Schouten, County Attorney, met with the Board this date.

Shane Walter, County Central Point of Coordination Administrator, met with the Board this date to request them to review a list of names of mentally ill, mentally retarded and substance abusers and determine which persons are financially responsible according to Chapters 125, 222 and 230, 1999 Iowa Code. The Board will investigate said list of names and make a final determination at the next meeting to be held on February 8, 2000.

Shane Walter, County Central Point of Coordination Administrator, reported on correspondence addressed to MH/DD Service Providers, Department of Human Service Social Workers and Department of Human Services Target Case Management Unit stating that Sioux County has enacted a waiting list for individuals seeking first time or additional MH/DD services with a diagnosis of mental illness, chronic mental illness or developmental disability.

Motion by Beernink and supported by De Haan to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the following documents:

Fiscal Agent Agreement with Mid-Sioux Opportunity, Inc., Remsen, for the Benefits for Beginners Program.

Carried, unanimous in favor with one member absent.

Mark Dunlop, County Emergency Management Services Director and Zoning Administrator, met with the Board this date to review two proposed rescue vehicle replacement plans. A final decision on which plan and financing method to implement will be made at the time of budget deliberations.

Doug Julius, County Engineer, met with the Board this date to request approval and a Chairman's signature on various documents.

Motion by De Haan and supported by Vander Maten to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the following documents:

Permit Agreement with Underground Developers, Inc., Sioux Falls, SD, for a road right-of-way crossing in Section 18 of Garfield Township.

Permit Agreement with Frontier Communications, Fort Dodge, for road right-of-way crossings in Sections 20, 30 and 31 of Nassau Township.

Carried, unanimous in favor with one member absent.

Doug Julius, County Engineer, estimated the total cost of a paving project around the City of Sioux Center to be an approximate amount of \$1,511,515.56. Most of the project would be paid for with RISE funds that the City of Sioux Center will be receiving.

The Board approved payment of claims as presented by the County Auditor from all departments.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting until Tuesday, February 8, 2000.
