

MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

MEETING HELD ON FEBRUARY 15, 2000

The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock A.M. with Chairman Loren Bouma presiding. Members present were William Vander Maten, Vernon Beernink, Loren Bouma and Bernard L. Smith. Stanley L. De Haan was absent.

Committee reports were given this date.

Mark Schouten, County Attorney, met with the Board this date to report that the civil commitment process will be fine tuned to include Shane Walter, County Central Point of Coordination Administrator, in the placement decision of court ordered mental health, substance abuse and juvenile individuals.

Mark Schouten, County Attorney, also reported that he will try and recoup monies paid to West Law Publishing for law library hard volume books that should not have been shipped to Sioux County. Hard copy books were to be replaced with CD-ROMS.

Dennis Sassman, County Community Services Director; and Donna Bomgaars, Income Maintenance Supervisor, met with the Board this date to report on the availability of state emergency assistance funds and the new Medicaid for Employed Persons with Disability program to become effective March 1, 2000.

Shane Walter, County Central Point of Coordination Administrator, met with the Board this date to review the format of a monthly MH/DD Service Expenditure report which categorizes the various types of MH/DD expenditures. He reviewed the consumer profiles of two individuals receiving mental health services. He also requested approval

and a Chairman's signature on an agreement to participate in a Northwest Iowa Contracting Consortium.

Motion by Beernink and supported by Vander Maten to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign an agreement to participate in a Northwest Iowa Contracting Consortium. Carried, unanimous in favor with one member absent.

Doug Julius, County Engineer, met with the Board this date to request approval and a Chairman's signature on an Iowa Department of Transportation Road Detour Agreement.

Motion by Smith and supported by Vander Maten to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign an Iowa Department of Transportation Road Detour Agreement to provide for the use of Sioux County Secondary Roads during the reconstruction of the roadway under Project STP-18-1(49)--2C-84 from the South Junction of US 18 and US 75 east to Division Street in Hull. Carried, unanimous in favor with one member absent.

Motion by Smith and supported by Beernink to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign a Class C Liquor License, Sunday Sales Privilege and Outdoor Service Area application for the Sandy Hollow Golf Association to be effective April 1, 2000. Carried, unanimous in favor with one member absent.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting until Tuesday, February 22, 2000.
