

MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MEETING HELD ON MARCH 25 2008

08-03-25 1 The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Dennis Wright, Vernon Beernink, Mark Sybesma, John Degen and Arlyn Kleinwolterink.

08-03-25 2 Minutes of the meeting held on March 11, 2008, were submitted and the Chairman declared them approved.

08-03-25 3 Coleman McAllister, County Attorney reported that his office, in conjunction with local Police Departments, is developing policies for investigating domestic and sexual assaults. Grant money has been received for this purpose.

08-03-25 4 Requests for annual liquor license renewals were received from Hull Golf Association and Sandy Hollow Club House. Motion by Wright and supported by Kleinwolterink to renew the annual liquor license for Hull Golf Association. Motion carried, unanimous in favor. Motion by Beernink and supported by Degen to renew the annual liquor license for Sandy Hollow Club House. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

08-03-25 5 Committee Reports:

- Wright and Sybesma reported that it is difficult to find people to serve on the Immigration Task Force.
- Beernink reported from the NW Iowa Planning and Development meeting that:
 - a. The interim director of NW Iowa Planning and Development Commission will be Ted Kourousis.
 - b. The Sioux County Planning and Zoning Ordinance update is nearing completion.
 - c. Four CDBG grants written by NW Iowa Planning and Development have been approved. Cities in Sioux County benefiting from these grants are: Ireton - \$150,000 for a Daycare Facility and Sioux Center - \$600,000 for the Family Crisis Center.
- Degen reported that the Sioux County Dive Team is in need of funds to purchase equipment.

08-03-25 6 Shane Walter, Community Services Director, requested that board approve a Community Mental Health Center Affiliation waiver. Motion by Wright and supported by Degen to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign a Community Mental Health Center Affiliation waiver. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

08-03-25 7 Motion by Kleinwolterink and supported by Wright to approve a Separation of Distance Waiver for Evan Blom, (E&W Poultry Farms) in Plato Township Section 3. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

08-03-25 8 As this was the date and 10:00a.m. the time set for a Public Hearing on an Iowa Department of Natural resources Construction Permit Application for Muilenburg Farms proposing a 2,400 head expansion of an existing swine operation, in Section 20 of Sherman

Township, said hearing was held according to law. Shane Walter, Zoning Administrator, noted that a favorable Matrix score was received. No comments either written or oral were received. Jerry Muilenburg was present for this discussion. The Chairman closed the hearing. Motion by Degen and supported by Kleinwolterink to recommended approval of the aforementioned permit approval to the Department of Natural Resources. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

08-03-25 9 Motion by and supported by to approve a Separation of Distance Waiver for Kirk Den Herder in Section 23 of West Branch Township. Motion by Beernink and supported by Degen to approve the separation of distance waiver requested by Kirk Den Herder. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

08-03-25 10 Toni Thompson, new account manager for Sioux County with Wellmark Blue Cross/Blue Shield introduced herself to the Board. She stated that the health coverage benefits offered through ISAC are very good.

08-03-25 11 Doug Julius, County Engineer

➤Requested Board approval and the Chairman's signature on the following permit agreements:

- OC Communications – Install Fiber optic Communications Cable NE of Orange City.
- Rock Valley Rural Water – Bore water line between Sections 4-5 and 5-6 of Rock Township.

Motion by Wright and supported by Degen to approve permits as submitted by the County Engineer. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

➤Requested that the Board sign a Certificate of Appreciation for Theodore Homan. Motion by Kleinwolterink and supported Degen to sign a Certificate of Appreciation for Theodore Homan. The Certificate acknowledges 26 years of service with the Sioux County Secondary Road Department. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

➤Distributed Asphalt Letting Bids submitted on March 20, 2008 for resurfacing of K64 and B30 in 2000. The bids were received for information.

➤Reported that negotiations continue by Sioux County Attorney, Coleman McAllister regarding a recent purchase of land.

➤Reviewed the five year construction plan for Roads, Bridges and Culverts.

08-03-25 12 Claims as submitted by the County Auditor were approved.

08-03-25 13 The Chairman adjourned the meeting at 11:25 a.m. until Tuesday, April 1, 2008.
