

## **MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

### **MEETING HELD ON MARCH 28, 2006**

The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Loren Bouma, Vernon Beernink, Mark Sybesma, John Degen and Stanley L. De Haan.

Minutes of the meeting held on March 14, 2006 were submitted and the Chairman declared them approved.

Motion by Bouma and supported by De Haan to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign a Class C Liquor License Renewal Application for Hull Golf Association effective April 1, 2006. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

As this was the date and 9:45 o'clock a.m. the time set for a Public Hearing on the Sioux County Mental Health/Developmental Disabilities Services Management Plan for Fiscal Years 2007-2009, said hearing was held. Shane Walter, Community Services Director, reviewed the proposed plan with the Board of Supervisors. The Chairman closed the hearing. Motion by Bouma and supported by Beernink to approve the aforementioned plan. Motion carried, unanimous in favor. A copy of the plan will be forwarded to the Iowa State Department of Human Services.

Motion by De Haan and supported by Degen to sign a Community Mental Health Center Waiver Request for the Creative Living Center. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

Update on Courthouse renovation: The office of Judge Scott on the third floor is being remodeled. The Sioux County Bar Association has finalized their request for retention of Law Library books.

As this was the date and 10:00 o'clock a.m. the time set for hearing on an Iowa Department of Natural Resources construction permit application submitted by Randy Kats, for a swine confinement building with deep pit, located in Section 11 of Rock Township, said hearing

was held. No written or oral objections were received. Present for the hearing were Randy Kats, Ken Kats and Jeff Koops. A letter will be forwarded to the DNR stating that this meeting was held. The Chairman closed the hearing.

Jim Raymond, Emergency Management Director, reported that the Department of Public Health in conjunction with six counties, including Sioux, will be conducting a training exercise which will take place over a period of approximately three weeks.

Severe Weather Awareness week is the first week in April. A statewide tornado alert will be held on Wednesday, April 5 beginning at 10:00 a.m.

Raymond reported that a zoning hearing will be held to discuss proposed telephone tower sites.

As this was the date and 10:15 o'clock a.m. the time set for hearing on an Iowa Department of Natural Resources construction permit application submitted by Pork Elite, LC, for a gilt barn with deep pit and farrowing barn with shallow pit, located in Section 10 of Washington Township, said hearing was held. No written or oral objections were received. Present for the hearing was Jeff Kayser, production manager of Pork Elite, LC. A letter will be forwarded to the DNR stating that this meeting was held. The Chairman closed the hearing.

An agreement to replace an Orange City Ambulance was presented to the Board by Raymond. Aiko Kamies, EMS coordinator for Orange City, reported on services provided by their organization. A little over 400 calls were received last year. The cost of the new ambulance is \$93,000, without equipment. Motion by De Haan and supported by Degen to fund the ambulance replacement for the city of Orange City. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

Douglas Julius, County Engineer, requested the Chairman's signature on various documents.

Julius requested that the supervisors sign the Title sheets for the following Urban Renewal Construction Projects.

Project Div I L-URD 1-06—73-84-GR Grade and Draining

Div II L-URD 2-06—73-84-GR Grade and Draining

Project L\_URD 1-06—73-84-CULV Concrete Culvert & Culvert Extensions

Motion by Degen and supported by Beernink to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the following permits:

- Rural Water System #1 – 2” water line 1/4 mile north of the intersection of Goldfinch Avenue and 380<sup>th</sup> Street in Plato Township and Welcome Townships
- Rural Water System #1 – 2” water line 1/8 mile south of the intersection of Kingbird Avenue and 350<sup>th</sup> Street in Section 13 of Capel and Section 18 of Lynn Townships
- Rural Water System #1 – 4” water line 1/8 mile east of the intersection of 340<sup>th</sup> Street and Kingbird Avenue between Section 6 and 7 of Lynn Township

Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

Julius presented the Sioux County five year construction program for Sioux review and comments before putting it into final form.

The Chairman signed a three year contract with the Sheriff’s Union.

At the February 28, 2006 Board of Supervisors meeting, Robert Hagey, County Treasurer, requested suspensions for five parcels of property. After reviewing the Resolution submitted, it was discovered that the dates submitted for suspension were incorrect; therefore that Resolution was not included in the minutes of that meeting. Following is the Resolution with the corrected dates:
