

MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

MEETING HELD ON APRIL 8, 2003

The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Loren Bouma, Vernon Beernink, Mark Sybesma, Bernard L. Smith and Stanley L. De Haan.

Minutes of April 1, 2003 were read and on motion and vote stand approved as read.

Committee reports were given this date.

The Board approved payment of claims as presented by the County Auditor from all departments this date.

Melissa O'Rourke, County Attorney; and Marla McGill, Victim/Witness Coordinator, met with the Board this date. April 6-12 has been designated as National Crime Victims' Rights Week.

Shane Walter, County Community Services Director, met with the Board this date.

Motion by Bouma and supported by Beernink to authorize the Chairman to sign the Department of Human Services Unit Targeted Case Management Contract, effective July 1, 2003, for three years. Carried, unanimous in favor.

Motion by Smith and supported by De Haan to authorize the Chairman to sign a three year, amendable, lease agreement between Sioux County and the Department of Human Services Targeted Case Management Unit for 774 square feet of office space in the Department of Human Services Building, at a cost of \$7.64 per square foot. Carried, unanimous in favor.

Motion by Beernink and supported by Smith to approve the proposal from Chem-Trol, Inc. to spray noxious weeds and leafy spurge in the western part of Sioux County for the 2003 growing season, in the amount of \$28,166.00 for the spring spraying of leafy spurge and noxious weeds, and

\$12,695.00 for the fall spraying of leafy spurge in the southwest corner of Sioux County. Carried,
unanimous in favor.
