

# MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

## MEETING HELD ON APRIL 15, 1997

The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock A.M. with Chairman Loren Bouma presiding. Members present were William Vander Maten, Vernon Beernink, Loren Bouma, Bernard L. Smith and Hubert Schuller.

The minutes of April 8, 1997, were read and on motion and vote stand approved as read. Committee reports were given this date.

Motion by Smith and supported by Schuller to approve the following late homestead and military tax credit claims:

Jan Cain, County Public Health Nurse/Administrator; and Randy Van Roekel, Homemaker-Home Health Aide Service Director, met with the Board this date to report that the Board must decide on the distribution of Sioux County's allocation of single county contract grant monies from the Iowa Department of Public Health.

Motion by Schuller and supported by Vander Maten to distribute Sioux County's entire allocation of the single county contract grant monies from the Iowa Department of Public Health to the Sioux County Public Health-Home Care of Sioux County for fiscal year 1997-98. The single county contract grant monies will be distributed in the categories and amounts as follows:

Home Care Aide	\$70,861.00
Public Health	23,734.00
Senior Health	5,930.00

Carried, unanimous in favor.

Motion by Beernink and supported by Vander Maten to approve Rules for Internet Service Use for Sioux County employees as proposed by Mark Schouten, County Attorney.

These Rules for Internet Service Use for Sioux County employees will be included as Section XVII of the Sioux County Personnel Policy. Carried, unanimous in favor.

The Board instructed Dennis Lange, County Auditor, to notify Krull Construction Inc., Orange City, that the Board has approved their proposal for restroom and shower alterations at Hope Haven Residential Training Center in an approximate amount of \$12,000.00.

The Chairman adjourned the meeting until Tuesday, April 22, 1997.
