

## MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

### MEETING HELD ON APRIL 22, 2014

- 14-04-22 1** The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met on April 22, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Al Bloemendaal, John Degen, Arlyn Kleinwolterink, Mark Sybesma, and Dennis Wright.
- 14-04-22 2** The minutes of the meeting held on April 14 were submitted, and the Chairman declared them approved.
- 14-04-22 3** Thomas Kunstle, Sioux County Attorney, has been in contact with an attorney in regard to the purchase of right-of-way near Trans Ova Genetics.
- 14-04-22 4** Shane Walter, Sioux County Community Services Director, reminded that board of a Sioux Rivers Regional Mental Health meeting in Le Mars this afternoon. On the agenda for that meeting are the approval of fiscal agreements and the authorization of forwarding signed 28E agreements to Des Moines. A representative of the Iowa Department of Human Services will meet with them today.
- 14-04-22 5** As this was the date and 9:15 a.m. the time for a public hearing to approve an application for the proposed construction of a new 2600 head deep pit swine finisher building in section 14 of Holland Township, the Chairman opened the hearing. Present for this discussion were Lyle Mars, owner, and Jeff Koops, Environmental Resource Specialist of Farmers Co-op Society. A letter was received from Randy and Rhonda Van Kalsbeek, who are concerned with the large number of hog confinements in a small area. There being no further comments from the public the Chairman closed the hearing. Motion by Kleinwolterink and supported by Degen to approve the construction of the aforementioned building. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.
- 14-04-22 6** A salary resolution was discussed, and will be finalized at a later date.
- 14-04-22 7** Doug Julius, Sioux County Engineer
- Submitted three contracts and contractors bonds for signature.
    - a. L-15-2003—73-84 CULV – Location: Chestnut Ave (K18 from Hwy 18 South 5 miles)
    - b. L-2-2012—73-84-CULV – Location: Lincoln Township sections 21-22
    - c. L-2-2014--73-84-CULV – Location: Capel Township sections 21-22
  - Permit agreements:
    - a. City of Granville – Run a water main in the ditch in the NW quarter of Section 12 of East Orange Township. Motion by Degen and supported by Bloemendaal to approve the permit request from the City of Granville to run a water line in East Orange Township. Motion carried, unanimous in favor

- b. Long Lines LTD – Install a 48 fiber optic communications cable to tie together existing fiber East of Alton to Orange City on the North side of 450<sup>th</sup> from existing vault in Section 34 to an existing Vault in Section 31 of Holland Township. Motion by Wright and supported by Bloemendaal to approve a permit for Long Lines LTD. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.
- Motion by Wright and supported by Bloemendaal to authorize the Chairman to sign DOT inspection sheets for FM projects and STP projects. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.
- Distributed a map of roads that were selected to paint this year at a cost of \$875.00 per mile.
- Explained what is happening on highway 18 near Rock Valley. The road around Rock Valley will be closed today. Traffic is being detoured through Carmel.

.COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- **Wright** – a) attended an executive board meeting at the YES Center. Financial issues continue to be a concern at the YES Center. A decision will need to be made to either close the center or to raise the rates. It will likely cost the county more with either option. A Juvenile Court Officer (JCO) makes the decision as to where a juvenile will be sent.

**14-04-22 8** Claims as submitted by the Auditor's office were approved for payment.
