

MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

MEETING HELD ON APRIL 25, 2000

The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock A.M. with Chairman Loren Bouma presiding. Members present were William Vander Maten, Vernon Beernink, Loren Bouma, Bernard L. Smith and Stanley L. De Haan.

Committee reports were given this date.

Motion by Smith and supported by De Haan to authorize the Chairman to sign upon final review and approval by Mark Schouten, County Attorney, an Agreement to Provide Services of the Community Services Grant to the Residents of Sioux County. Carried, unanimous in favor.

Mark Schouten, County Attorney; and Lois Huitink, Data Processing/Real Estate Clerk, met with the Board this date to give an update on the new computer system and software installation for all affected county departments. They stated that the next phases to be considered by the Board would be the purchase of additional servers to accommodate department e-mail, Internet and public web-site access. Mark Schouten, County Attorney, stated that hooking up to a faster T-1 Internet line connection would be an approximate amount of \$650.00 per month through the City of Orange City.

The Board deferred a decision on any of the aforementioned computer phase-ins.

Robert Hagey, County Treasurer, met with the Board this date to request approval on various tax abatements.
