

MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MEETING HELD ON JUNE 26, 2007

07-06-26 1 The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:30 o'clock a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Dennis Wright, Vernon Beernink, Mark Sybesma, John Degen and Arlyn Kleinwolverink.

07-06-26 2 Minutes of the meeting held on June 12, 2007, were submitted and the Chairman declared them approved.

07-06-26 3 Coleman McAllister, County Attorney

- Gave a report on fine collection for May and June
- Reported that the ALTA Grant for \$3,500 was approved.
- One matter of litigation is pending for the Board of Review

07-06-26 4 Micah Van Maanen introduced the new IT/GIS assistant, Ryan Dokter. Van Maanen reported that the courtroom audio system is now working properly.

07-06-26 5 Shane Walter, County Community Services Director

- Distributed the June 2007 Expenditure Report
- Reported that the Hope Haven Residential Training Center will need additional financial support for the Residential Training Center.
- County Attorney, McAllister reported that the recent Planning and Zoning meeting dealt with the Comprehensive Use Plan designed by the Planning and Zoning Commission. He advised the Board that citizens may take exception to enforcement of the plan and that notification of the public is essential.
- Distributed a DHS Case Management Report

07-06-26 6 Randy Feenstra, County Treasurer

- Presented an overview of the 2007 tax sale: 39 bidders were present, only Mobile Homes were left unpaid.
- Requested the abatement of tax on eight tax parcels. Motion by Beernink and supported by Wright to abate taxes on eight parcels of property submitted by Feenstra. Roll call on Vote: Wright, Yes; Beernink, Yes; Degen, Yes; Kleinwolverink, Yes; and Sybesma, Yes. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.
- Requested that Cynthia Reed and Beth Wassenaar, employees in the Treasurer's office, be allowed an increase of \$.50 in their hourly rate of pay. Motion by Wright and supported by Degen to grant a \$.50 per hour raise in pay to Cynthia Reed and Beth Wassenaar. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

07-06-26 7 Doug Julius, County Engineer met with the Board regarding the following matters:

- Requested that the Board approve and the Chairman sign several permit agreements. Motion by Wright and supported by Kleinwolterink to approve the following permit agreements:
 - Northwest REC – Set Poles in Sections 11 and 12 of Lincoln Township.
 - Rock Valley Rural Water – run water line between Sections 4 and 9 of Plato Township.

Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

- Requested the chairman’s signature on a Road Closure Resolution. Motion by Beernink and supported by Degen to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign a Road Closure Resolution for Construction during the 2007-2008 season. Roll Call on Vote: Kleinwolterink, Yes; Degen, Yes; Beernink, Yes, Wright, Yes; and Sybesma, Yes. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.
