A final decision regarding a delinquent property tax matter involving a City of Alton/Midwest Farmers Coop real estate transaction will be deferred until the end of September, 1999.

Mark Schouten, County Attorney, met with the Board this date to report on a fiber-optic matter which involves the ownership of unused fiber-optic cable strands in the cable running from Northwestern College to various Sioux County, City of Orange City, Orange City Hospital and school buildings. He stated that a multiplex device could be purchased in an approximate amount of \$13,000.00 and installed to expand service of the fiber-optic lines already brought to the Court House. The cost of the multiplex device may be recouped through a grant from the Immigration and Naturalization Service. The Board instructed Mark Schouten, County Attorney, to continue negotiations with the City

of Orange City regarding potential Sioux County ownership of the unused fiber-optic cable strands.

Robert Hagey, County Treasurer, met with the Board this date to request approval on various property tax abatements.
