**09-11-05 5** A request for a letter of support was received from Mid-Sioux Opportunity Inc. Mid-Sioux is applying for a 2010 HSOG (Homeless Shelter Operations Grant). This funding provides rent and utility assistance to low-income families in a five county service area. Motion by Bloemendaal and supported by Kleinwolterink to send a letter of support to Mid-Sioux Opportunity Inc. for their application for a 2010 Homeless Shelter operations Grant. **09-11-05 6** The legal description was revised on a Letter of Agreement with the City of Sioux Center in regards to the Sioux County TIF Area Amendment. The revised document was signed by the vice-chairman.
