Some of the topics and concerns to be investigated further were as follows:

Utilization of pre-cast, cement block or poured concrete walls for cell blocks.  
Potential plumbing problems with pre-cast walls for cell blocks.  
Obtain more information on Iowa Communications Network equipment located in County Sheriff's Department to be moved to new facility.  
Centralization of County Sheriff's Office for public access.  
No fueling on site.  
Placement of conduits in unfinished rooms.  
Contract with local provider or equip kitchen for inmate meals.

Doug Julius, County Engineer, met with the Board this date to review bids on blades as follows:

Doug Julius, County Engineer, reported that he accepted the low bid from Utility Equipment, Des Moines, for the purchase of blades in an amount of \$19,342.59. The lower bid from Midwest Service & Sales, Schuyler, Nebraska, did not meet specifications.

The Board approved and signed a certificate of appreciation for Bryan De Jong for his 14 years of outstanding service and contributions to Sioux County as a technician in the County Engineer's office.
