

MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 15, 2011

11-11-15 1 The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:00 o'clock a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Al Bloemendaal, John Degen, Arlyn Kleinwolterink, Mark Sybesma and Dennis Wright.

11-11-15 2 Minutes of the meeting held on November 10, 2011, were submitted and the Chairman declared them approved.

11-11-15 3 Lisa Rowenhorst, Sioux County Elections Administrator presented results of the Regular City Elections held on November 8, 2011. The Board canvassed the tally lists of votes cast in the regular city election for cities in the County who have adopted Chapter 44/45 and Primary Election Ordinances. Complete election results are on file in the Auditor's Office. Those cities are Boyden, Chatsworth, Granville, Hawarden, Hospers, Hull, Ireton, Matlock and Maurice. For the city of Hospers there were three open seats for City Council, with one candidate on the Ballot. John Solsma was elected with 33.55 percent of the votes cast. Mike Thompson received 9.03% of the vote as a write-in candidate. Three other persons received the same number of write-in votes (4.52% of the votes cast. According to Iowa Code those three names were placed in a container and the first name drawn was Ben Hamblin. Hamblin will be elected unless he declines the position by tomorrow evening, November 16 at 5:00 p.m. The second name drawn was John Klynsma. If Hamblin declines to serve, the position will be filled by Klynsma. If Klynsma also declines to serve the position will be filled by the Hospers City Council. Motion by Kleinwolterink and supported by Degen to approve the canvass of the votes cast at the regular city election held on November 8, 2011. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

11-11-15 4 COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- **Dennis Wright** - a) Went to a YES Board meeting on Friday. A problem exists because Buena Vista County has a 28-E Agreement with Central Iowa as well as with the YES Board. When a juvenile is sent to treatment, the judge decides where they are to go. Buena Vista County is refusing to pay for services at the YES Center, citing that treatment with Central Iowa is less costly. b) Attended a Northwest Iowa Consortium meeting yesterday. Committee reports prepared by the Consortium will be sent to the legislature.
- **Kleinwolterink** - Reported that a compactor needs to be repaired at the Northwest Iowa Landfill.
- **Sybesma** - Northwest Iowa Early Childhood Development Board met and revenue is down from last year.

11-11-15 5 Doug Julius, Sioux County Engineer

- Submitted three items for Board approval and the Chairman's signature. Completion of work and acceptance documents were submitted for the following projects:
BROS CO84(138)—8J-84 - Concrete slab bridge located 1/8 mile south of US Hwy 18 between Sections 27 and 28 in Rock Township.
L-12-2007—73-84 - Concrete slab bridge located on 470th Street between Sections 9 and 16 of Nassau Township.

L-7-2011—73-84-CULV – Pipe arch culvert located on Dove Avenue west of Section 6 in Plato Township.

Motion by Wright and supported by Bloemendaal to approve items as presented by the Sioux County Engineer. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

- Distributed the official report of the Secondary Road Fund for Fiscal Year 2011 for the Boards' information.

11-11-15 6 Claims as submitted by the Auditor were approved for payment.

11-11-15 7 The Chairman adjourned the meeting at 9:35 a.m. until 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, November 15, 2011.
