

**MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**  
**MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 30, 2010**

**10-11-30 1** The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:00 o'clock a.m. with Chairman Mark Sybesma presiding. Members present were Al Bloemendaal, John Degen, Arlyn Kleinwolterink, Mark Sybesma and Dennis Wright.

**10-11-30 2** Minutes of the meeting held on November 23, 2010, were submitted and the Chairman declared them approved.

**10-11-30 3** Coleman McAllister, Sioux County Attorney reported that the courts ruled in favor of Sioux County in the Kramer vs. Sioux County case. Kramer had claimed that the property in question is agricultural and therefore was exempt from zoning regulations. The court ruled that the property was used to handle industrial waste. In a second phase of this case, Kramer is pleading that the fines imposed by the County are unreasonable. The County has filed a motion to dismiss this case. The court will brief the case and decide whether to hear or dismiss it.

**10-11-30 4** Sybesma requested that the Board approve letters to the cities of Hawarden, Hull, Ireton and Orange City asking for reimbursement for restoration projects done by Northwest Iowa Housing Trust Fund. Sioux County initially paid \$17,148.00 for the project. Motion by Degen and supported by Kleinwolterink to approve billing the cities for work done in those cities. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

**10-11-30 5** Cynthia Bauman, Executive Director of NW Iowa Aging Association thanked the Board for its' past support and to requested funding for the 2011-2012 budget year. She reported that the State funded Senior Living Trust has been spent, so money for senior citizens programs has been rolled into general appropriations.

Last year the amount budgeted by Sioux County for NW Iowa Aging was \$5,000.00. Bauman requested that support for next year to be increased from the current level to \$15,944.00 which equates to \$2.70 for each individual in the County who is over 60. Mabel Mantel was present for this discussion. Bauman acknowledged the work that Mantel does by helping elders understand Medicare law and its' provisions.

**10-11-30 6** Shane Walter, Community Services Director distributed the November MH/DD Expenditure report. Walter noted that at this point expenditures are less than anticipated. He explained that local service providers help keep costs in line.

**10-11-30 7** Doug Julius, Sioux County Engineer
