

MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MEETING HELD ON DECEMBER 10, 2001

The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa met pursuant to adjournment at 9:00 clock a.m. with Chairman Loren Bouma presiding. Members present were Mark Sybesma, Loren Bouma, Vern Beernink and Stanley L. De Haan. Member Bernie Smith was absent.

Minutes of December 4, 2001 that were previously sent stand approved as read.

Committee reports were discussed.

Jan Vander Zwaag, Deputy County Auditor, reported on the canvass of the Boyden Municipal Runoff Election returns for the City of Boyden for the election held on December 4, 2001.

The Board approved the canvass of the Boyden Municipal Runoff Election returns for the election held on December 4, 2001 as follows:

Since the above contest ended in a tie vote, Section 50.44, Code of Iowa, requires the election of one of them to be chosen by lot. In the presence of the Board of Canvassers, one of them shall publicly draw one of such names out of a receptacle, and such person shall be declared elected. Member Stanley L. De Haan proceeded to draw the name of Dale Winter out of a receptacle and was declared elected.
