

## MINUTES OF SIOUX COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

### MEETING HELD ON JANUARY 23, 2018

- 1) The Board of Supervisors of Sioux County, Iowa, met pursuant to adjournment at 9:00 a.m. with Chairman Sybesma presiding. Members present were John Degen, Mark Sybesma, Dennis Wright, Arlyn Kleinwolterink, and Al Bloemendaal.
- 2) Minutes of the meeting held on January 16, 2018, were submitted, and the Chairman declared them approved.
- 3) Claims were approved for January 23, 2018 as submitted by the County Auditor.
- 4) Shane Walter, CEO, Sioux Rivers Mental Health and Aaron Haverdink, Sioux County Mental Health Service Coordinator, reviewed the following departmental budgets with the Board: Mental Health, Juvenile Probation, General Welfare(Assistance), Veteran's Affairs, Social Services, Zoning, and Environmental Health.
- 5) Anita Van Bruggen, Sioux County Recorder, submitted the October 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 quarterly report to the Board for information.
- 6) The Board received the October 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017, Sheriff quarterly report for information.
- 7) Doug Julius, Sioux County Engineer,
  - Updated the Board on the Federal Aid Swap.
  - Secondary road department is working cleanup from the recent snow storm.
- 8) Committee Reports:
  - **Kleinwolterink** – Attended a Wellness committee meeting and a Safety committee meeting.
  - **Degen** – 1) Reported on the E911 and EMS budget meetings and the budgets, 2) attended a fishing clinic at the south pit in Hawarden on Saturday.
  - **Wright** – Reported on the ISAC Board meeting from January 19. A consulting firm has been hired by ISAC to examine the health insurance plans. Attendance at ISAC University was approximately 200 people, the Statewide Supervisor meeting has roughly 85 people registered, and the Spring School has roughly 500 registered. Also reported that 44 counties have signed on with the opioid litigation.
  - **Kleinwolterink & Degen** – Attended a Security Committee meeting in which Jeremy Sroka was brought in to do a security assessment of the Courthouse. A full report will be provided at a later date from Mr. Sroka.
  - **Wright & Bloemendaal** – Reported on ISAC University held January 17 and 18. The training focused on leadership and many good speakers presented.
  - **Wright & Sybesma** – Reported on a meeting from January 20 with Shane Walter, along with Representative Chuck Holz, Senator Jim Carlin, and Senator Randy Feenstra in regards to United Health taking on the role with integrated health homes. By doing this, the primary physician would handle both physical and mental needs of the patient, and in turn would have a devastating effect on the patients care. This would

also mean payments would end to Siouxland Mental Health and Plains Area Mental Health, which amounts to approximately 50% of their revenue.
