REPEAL RESOLUTION 84-12


WHEREAS, Section 331.427, subsection 2, paragraph K, Code Supplement 1983, relating to the payment of bounties on wild animals has been repealed effective July 1, 1984;

WHEREAS, the Sioux County Board of Supervisors previously considered and adopted Resolution No. 84-12 wherein the Sioux County Board of Supervisors continued the payment of bounties on pocket gophers trapped in Sioux County with said bounty paid at \$.75 per front pair of pocket gopher feet.

WHEREAS, the Sioux County Board of Supervisors desires to repeal Resolution No. 84-12 in full;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, effective immediately, Resolution No. 84-12 adopted by the Sioux County Board of Supervisors on June 26, 1984, is hereby repealed and shall be of no further legal effect. In addition, any other resolutions that are in conflict with this resolution are likewise repealed, but only to the extent that they conflict with this resolution.
