- Introduced a new part-time Detention Officer, Abby Krull. Requested that the Chairman sign a certificate of appointment for Krull. - Reported that \$21,000 will need to be spent on new radios for the patrol vehicles in the current fiscal year. Narrow band transmission is required by 2012.

No one was present from the public to make comments either for or against the proposed budget. The Public Hearing was closed.

10-03-02 6 Doug Julius, Sioux County Engineer

- Presented a permit for Board approval:
 - **Southern Sioux Rural Water** –Bore water line under Dipper Avenue in county R-O-W adjacent to county Highway B-46 between section 14 and 15 of Eagle Township.

Motion by Degen and supported by Kleinwolterink to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the aforementioned permit agreement. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

- Requested board approval and the Chairman's signature on a Regional SAFTEA-LU application in the amount of \$645,000. This project STP-S-CO84()—55-84 will consist of cold-in-place recycling of asphalt cement concrete pavement on Chestnut Avenue (K18) from 360th Street (B30) north approximately 4.75 miles to Iowa Hwy 18 west of Rock Valley.

Motion by Bloemendaal and supported by Wright to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the aforementioned SAFTEA-LU application Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

- Submitted a Cash Lease agreement between Sioux County and Phil Hooyer for the lease of 6.36 acres more or less in Section 15 of Buncombe Township for \$810.00.

Motion by Degen and supported by Kleinwolterink to approve the aforementioned Cash Lease agreement with Phil Hooyer beginning March 1, 2010 and ending March 1, 2011. Motion carried, unanimous in favor.

10-03-02 7 Shane Walter, Sioux County Community Services Director requested.

- Reported that the Zoning meeting scheduled for the March 18, 2010 has been cancelled. The Board of Adjustment will meet at 1:00 p.m. on that day.
- Informed the Board that proposed legislative redesign of State government will have an impact on jobs and on how business is conducted in Des Moines. It is likely that the State payment program will be cut again. There is a waiting list for this program now. To gain settlement a client must live in a county for 12 consecutive months. The County will need to review those that are disenrolled and compare the costs of prevention against the cost of treatment for them. Walter reported that approximately 15-20 Sioux County residents are enrolled in the State payment program at any given time.

10-03-02 8 As this was the date and 10:30 o'clock a.m. the time appointed for a Public Hearing on a Flood Insurance Ordinance the Chairman opened said public hearing. Shane Walter, County Planning and Zoning Administrator said that Resolution No. 2009-27 stated that it was the Counties intent to participate in the National Flood Insurance program. The second phase required to participate in the program is to adopt a Flood Insurance Ordinance. This is the first official reading of this document. No public input, either written or oral was received. The Public Hearing was closed.

10-03-02 9 COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Bloemendaal – Attended a Greater Siouxland Community Health Center meeting. The annual audit report was reviewed. The center continues to raise money for the Bright Smiles Campaign, which will add a dental clinic to the center. Construction should start for that program in June.
- Sybesma, Bloemendaal and Wright attended a meeting at Dordt College which addressed immigration issues.
